

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY
H STREET BRIDGE NE REPLACEMENT
ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT RELEASED FOR PUBLIC COMMENT**

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has released for public comment the Environmental Assessment (EA) for the H Street Bridge NE Replacement. The purpose of the Project is to replace the H Street Bridge NE (Hopscotch Bridge) to address structural deficiencies, maintain modal relationships, and support the economic development within and adjacent to the Washington Union Station.

The EA was prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) and evaluates the proposed replacement and documents alternatives considered, their potential impacts and strategies to mitigate them.
